Principal Accountabilities

1	Engage with all training and support requirements
2	Assist with delivering campaign outreach
3	Contribute towards the monitoring and evaluation of UNISEX's campaigns

Specific Duties

1	Engage with all training and support requirements
1.1	Attend UNISEX induction session once per year
1.2	Attend campaign specific training for each campaign you wish to take part in
1.3	Take an active and vocal role in training and engage with the group
1.4	Take responsibility for your own learning and seek help if required
1.5	Be aware of your support needs and access support when required
2	Assist with delivering campaign outreach
2.1	Undertake at least 4 hours of outreach work for each campaign
2.2	Maintain a friendly, non-judgemental and approachable attitude on outreach
2.3	Distribute resources as determined by the campaign
2.4	Facilitate chlamydia screening where appropriate
2.5	Uphold confidentiality at all times (please see Confidentiality policy)
2.6	Comply to outreach guidelines (page _) and other relevant policies and procedures
2.7	Represent UNISEX to a high standard at all times
3	Contribute towards the monitoring and evaluation of UNISEX's campaigns
3.1	Contribute to the quantitative and qualitative monitoring of outreach sessions where instructed by the Campaigns Co-ordinator
3.2	Complete a Campaign Evaluation Form in as much detail as possible for each campaign you are involved with
